Teaching Fellowship awarded by the Department of Visual Arts. A self-designed course that incorporates elements of collaboration, performance, technical lighting and editing skills for cinema production in order to have a more expansive approach to teaching digital video. Detailed course description listed below:

"We Are All Passengers on This Wrecked Cruise Ship of Love"

The nature of this course investigates the cruise ship as a metaphor for the convergent site of the body politic. The activities we create up on deck are not just for entertainment, but for discovering how form can help acclimate the body to environmental systems. How do we as a society, culturally and spatially designate ourselves? The class will be broken down into three separate parts, and be guided by selected readings and screening, but otherwise the development of the class will be determined by its nascent collective structure. Since this course is very collaborative, there will be a number of group projects. Through cooperative building, writing, and performing, form will be studied as a means to communicate this myriad content. This is not negotiable. Genres cultivated and explored will include, but are not limited to: Sculpture, Video, Performance, Script-writing, and Theater Set/Stage/Props Design.

L'ECLISSE redux: Advanced film and studio seminar at Siena Art Institute with Bureau for Open Culture, Siena, Italy, Fall 2013.

In Siena, Italy at the Siena Art Institute, I co-taught a course on the film "L'eclisse" by Michelangelo Antonioni with my collaborator James Voorhies of Bureau for Open Culture. The course *L'ECLISSE redux* focused on engaging students, and transpired through a series of public seminars that took place over the course of six weeks, operating temporarily out of the former space of a street-level gallery at Via del Poggio 2, in the center of Siena. The space was simultaneously a studio, exhibition and learning site where 24 film stills from *L'eclisse* were selected, printed and installed. The stills were used as framework and guide for discussing broad topics such as alienation, architecture, economy, love and urbanization as related to Siena. Antonioni's filmmaking techniques, character development and narrative structure were analyzed within this context. The film is an object—a spine—along which visual responses in photography, collage, writing, video, painting, drawing and performance accrue during the exhibition.
